









The 2023 MAFTO Care Package will build on the relationships we share with the Mid-Atlantic community to raise funds for Philabundance, Small Things and MAFTO charities. Participants that donate food, consumer products, gift cards, and free goods coupons are recognized for their efforts, while care packages provide value to

consumers, recognize essential workers and support those in need.

- Up to 20 brands and local establishments are targeted to participate in the care packages.
- The MAFTO Community Care Package will be primarily offered to corporate donors who order \$5,000-\$10,000 or more at \$100 per package to support Philabundance, Small Things, and other community food charities and pantries. Larger donations qualify for special events, MAFTO public relations, social media and OutFront billboard recognition program.
- The program will be promoted by MAFTO, Philabundance, Small Things, and other food banks.
- Individual care package orders and donations can be made online via the MAFTO.org website for delivery in February and March of 2023.
- The program has generated over \$150,000 in donations in its first two years. With your help we can donate \$100,000 or more in 2023.

How to participate:

- Donate 1,000 or 2,000* non-perishable food products, free goods coupons, non-alcoholic beverages, gift cards, sundries.

- Please provide your donation between Dec. 21, 2022 Jan. 31, 2023. Products and coupons with at least a 4 to 6 month expiration date (from January 2nd, 2023) are preferred.

Now, more than a year later, the need hasn't abated and Small Things provides food to more than 75 partners across Philadelphia. It has hosted more than 2,000 volunteers to pack food boxes at the Roxborough warehouse, and is on track to give

away 8 million pounds of food in 2021.
